



1798 Town of Montgomery Map for David Galatian and William H. Smith—the site of the Mill at the Upper Falls was owned by Levi P. Graham

1803—John Haggerty of the City of New York sold the Mill, the Mill seat and 106 acres of land to John Brower Jr. Haggerty held the mortgage.

1804—John Brower Jr. died seized, owing on the mortgaged property. Brower was from the Town of Montgomery.

1805—John Haggerty fixed a bill of complaint in Chancery Court attempting to obtain payment from the Estate of John Brower Jr.

1805—The Executors of the Estate of John Brower Jr. sold the Mill, the Mill seat and 106 acres to Benjamin Thorne and James Teller of Fishkill.

1810—Benjamin Thorne and James Teller relinquished the Mill, the Mill seat and 106 acres to their creditors, including Merchants Henry Rankin and Garret Heyer of New York City.

1815—Henry Rankin and Garret Heyer, Merchants of New York City, sold the Mill, the Mill seat and 106 acres to Jacob T. Walden of the Town of Montgomery. There is also a deed between the Executors of the Estate of John Brower Jr. and Jacob T. Walden.



1797—Jacob and Thomas Walden are listed in the New York City Directory. They were shipping merchants in the cotton trade. They were the sons of Jacob Walden and Abigail Loud of Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

1802—Jacob Walden married Maria Pell, daughter of Benjamin Pell and Mary Ann Ferris in New York City.

1807—Thomas Walden married Esther Franklin, daughter of Abraham and Ann Franklin.

1812—Jacob and Thomas Walden ended the shipping business they had conducted since their arrival in New York City.

1812—Jacob T. Walden purchased property in the Town of Montgomery from John and Elinor McElheny, part of the original Gatehouse Patent.

1813—Jacob Walden listed in NYC Directory as Merchant with brother Thomas at 60 South Street.

1813—Jacob T. Walden purchased additional property in the Town of Montgomery also part of the Gatehouse Patent, from Thomas Fullerton.

1814—Only Thomas and Daniel Walden are listed in the New York City Directory.
